## STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

### UT RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

"In residence" refers to courses taken at UT Austin; it does not include creditby-exam, extension, or distance education courses. All of the following must be completed in residence:

- At least two long semesters or an equivalent period of time.
- A total of 60 hours.
- 24 hours in business, on a letter-grade basis.
- 12 upper-division hours, on a letter-grade basis, from the major coursework.

## **Core Curriculum**

All students pursuing an undergraduate degree at the University must complete the forty-two-hour statewide core curriculum. The list of courses students should choose from to fulfill their core requirements is updated annually and published in the General Information Catalog.
